OUR PARTNERS

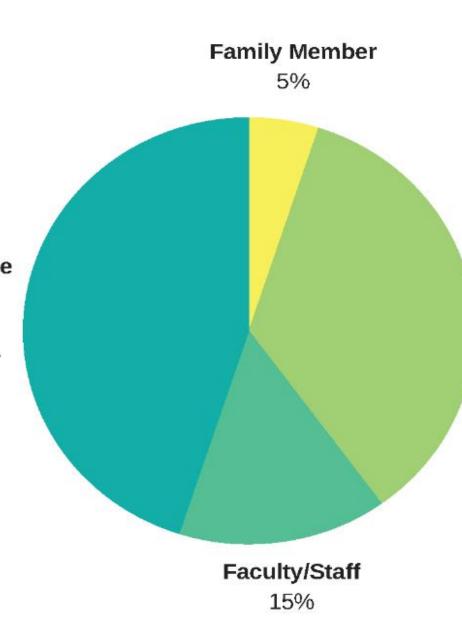

and the E3 Farmers' Market in Bruin Plaza.

83% of participants reported that they gained knowledge, information, and /or skills that will benefit their overall health or well-being. Participants reported that the recipes were tasty, easy, and affordable. Many participants also stated they were likely to make the recipes regularly.
